DID YOU KNOW?

- ✓ Prostate cancer is the second largest cancer killer of men but screening and early treatment have reduced prostate cancer deaths.
- ✓ Prostate cancer is the most common cancer and the second leading cause of cancer death in African Americans, whose prostate cancer death rate is more than twice as high as Caucasians.
- ✓ Men age 40 and over should talk with their health care professional about having a prostate-specific antigen (PSA) blood test and a digital rectal exam (DRE) every year.
